### THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

The sprawling campus is spread over 25000 Sq Yards of land set amidst scenic surroundings at Goner Road, Shri Ramchandrapura near Akshay Patra Temple, Jagatpura, Jaipur. The Institution has Excellent imposing buildings with spacious Class Rooms, Laboratories with the State of the Art equipment and other excellent infrastructure facilities. The main block of college is a four- storey building with basement and incorporated with many features of a green building like rainwater harvesting system and water recycling plant etc. The playground is lush green, surrounded by eye-catching perennial and flowering trees. The college is well connected with public transport.

### THE ADMINISTRATION BLOCK

#### RECEPTION

A very magnificent reception area is the foremost place where all kinds of enquiries are being entertained along with welcoming new students, guardians, dignitaries and others. We have deployed the best college staff to resolve all the queries regarding counselling, admission procedure and other college related matters. Counsellors and the faculty members guide the students as per their needs, interest and capability.



#### THE ADMISSION CELL

A pre-admission counselling cell is set-up to answer queries and give general admission guidelines to admission seekers. The members of admission counseling cell are available during working days between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. The concerned faculties of subjects are acting members of the admission committee, to take care of admission and career related queries bubbling within the new students and their parents.

#### ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

The well-furnished administration office run by qualified and dedicated staff is the core center to streamline and systemize the functioning of the college. This also serves as the students' information center.

#### THE STAFF ROOM

The staff room is not only a sitting area for the faculty members but also the place of thought and knowledge sharing among themselves. It is comfortable and spacious with various facilities, like computer system, Wi-Fi, individual lockers etc.

#### THE EXAMINATION CELL

There is a separate examination cell established in the college, headed by the examination controller, for organizing hassle free internal and external examination. It also manages and organizes the university practical examination of the college students following the guidelines of the University of Rajasthan.





## THE ACADEMIC BLOCK

This is the place where teachers and students interact and share their knowledge through teaching and learning process. The college has highly qualified, experienced, dedicated and professional faculty. As per our commitment for guaranteed high quality and up-to-date study program, guest lectures, seminars and faculty development programs are organized time to time as per the needs of students and faculty members.

The Academic block houses the following mentioned infrastructure:

### THE LIBRARY

*"Libraries store the energy that fuels the imagination. They open up windows to the world and inspire us to explore and achieve and contribute to improving our quality of life."*

The college has well-stocked library with a large number of books on subjects related to the courses taught. The college subscribes to all important newspapers, magazines, national and international books and journals. To this effect the library has adopted a sound and user responsive collection building policy. The library has been constantly acquiring, organizing and processing conventional as well as electronic learning resources for the student community.

### THE BOOKS & JOURNALS SECTION

The vast library houses a diverse collection of over 5121 books published by leading national and international publishing houses in disciplines of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany and Geography), Commerce, Computer Science, Humanities, Business Administration and various motivational & inspiring books. Library provides question papers of previous years, of University of Rajasthan. For awareness about the day-to-day events, the library provides the following magazines, journals, six leading newspapers, employment newspaper.

### READING SECTION

Library has a quiet learning environment. We provide separate reading sections for faculty members and students where discipline and peace are maintained by well-trained senior library head and staff.





## RULES & REGULATIONS FOR LIBRARY

- A student will be permitted to enter library only by presenting his/her identity cum library card and must sign in/out in the register available at library gate.
- The library provides two library cards per student and two books per library card can be issued to them. Cards are not exchangeable.



- A student is allowed to keep a book for 14 days at a time from the date of issue and if the book is not demanded by other student the same can be reissued for further 14 days.
- If a student fails to return the book within the stipulated period, he/she will be penalized with a fine of Rs.5/- per day per book.
- It is duty of the student to keep the library book in good condition and should not deface, mark, cut, mutilate or damage the reading material in any way. A student doing so will be fined heavily, apart from being asked to pay the cost of the damaged publication.
- If the issued book is lost, the responsibility has to be borne by the borrower and he/she has to deposit another copy of the book of the same or the latest edition. If the book is not replaced, one has to deposit double cost of the book as fine.
- As the library is automated/ computerized hence, any damage caused to the barcode of the book is subjected to a fine of Rs 100 for each book
- In case of loss of Library I.D a duplicate may be issued on Payment of Rs 100/-.
- Personal belongings are not allowed inside the library. They can be kept at the entrance.
- Students are requested to maintain silence and not to disturb others.
- Smoking, eating, talking, using mobile phones, etc., are strictly prohibited

## LIBRARY DISCIPLINE

The college takes a serious view of any form of indiscipline with respect to the library. Indiscipline includes creating noise and any kind of disturbance inside the library, damaging books, furniture or any other library property. The students are expected to behave decently and maintain the library decorum.

### SEMINAR HALL/ AUDITORIUM

The college campus has two hi-tech and well-lit seminar halls with luxurious seating capacity of 500 each and is equipped with white board, LCD projector and proper sound system. One of them two is fully air-conditioned. The college keeps on inviting, from time to time, renowned academicians and intellectuals in different spheres for addressing the students and the teaching staff on various subjects, topics of academics and other co-related pursuits with a view to widen the horizon of knowledge of the students and staff as well. This is the place where intellectual ideas are shared among the students for their personality development. Various exhibitions, workshops, seminars, presentations, cultural activities are being organized in these auditoriums.

### CLASS ROOMS & TUTORIAL ROOMS

The Academic block houses thirty spacious and fully lightened classrooms. It includes two well laid-out lecture theatres with seating capacity of 100 each, twenty four lecture rooms having capacity of 60-70 and four Tutorial Rooms with a capacity of 30 each to make students proactive while learning.

### THE GLOBAL LIBRARY - FOR THE STUDENTS BY THE STUDENTS

Self study is the best way of imbibing self-discipline and self-management among an individual. Based on this concept, a special library, the Global Library for the students by the students was established. This small library is enriched with books on various subjects which are donated by the faculty members from time to time. It has a well planned infrastructure too for reading and seating. The speciality of this library is that this is for the students and being run by the students themselves. A few volunteer students run this small library and manage the accounting themselves. The students spend their time here and interact with each other and discuss their study materials as well.

## OUTDOOR SPORTS GROUND

The college always supports sports activities. The college has a large lush green playground with facilities for various games like Tennis, Volley-ball, Football, Badminton, Hockey etc in the campus. The college conducts annual sports meet and encourages students to participate in the inter college events. Our college volleyball team played in various state level championships. In addition to team games, individuals have excelled at college and university level.



## COMMON ROOM

*"The end of labor is to gain leisure."*

The institute provides a facility of separate common rooms for boys and girls. The common rooms serve as a centre of recreational activities for the students as they indulge in discussions on various topics related to their interest area. The common room has magazines, newspapers etc. The students refresh themselves and utilize their leisure period in fruitful activities viz. subject related discussions, sharing their views and knowledge, planning of extracurricular activities etc. Both common rooms are governed and guided by the discipline committee under the Head of the Institute.



## PARKING AREA

Ample Parking facility for both faculties and students is available. More than 300 vehicles can be parked at a time. For the security of the vehicles 24 hours CCTV Cameras are installed. About 2 to 3 Guards are always on duty for the security of the vehicles.

## GYMNASIUM

*"Good health and good sense are two of life's greatest blessings."*

A well equipped gymnasium is open for the students. The college provides gymnasium with the latest fitness equipments and an exercise room where health education is provided to the students. The gymnasium is equipped with cardio and body building machines like fully automatic treadmill, Cross runner, electronic cycle, dumbbells and rods, triceps bars, multi functional benches etc.



## INDOOR GAMES

The indoor stadium of the college provides A-class indoor games facilities where students can play and enjoy games like Badminton, Table Tennis, Carrom and Chess etc. The college students avail and enjoy various games facilities after their classes. Annual sports day provides a good opportunity to students to show their sportsmanship and grow better.





## LABORATORIES

The college has Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Geography and Computer laboratories to facilitate 'learning by doing'.

The students are guided by devoted and expert faculties of the department to perform experiments, measure data and analyze results so as to match their practical observations with theoretical knowledge. The college also maintains a well developed botanical garden to cater to the needs of students of Botany.

## PHYSICS LAB

*"In physics you cannot just make stuff up and presume that it is a proper account of nature. At the end of the day you have to answer to nature".*

- The department has three well established laboratories having capacity of conducting practical for 30 students at a time in each lab. The labs are well furnished with ample space for students to work freely.
- The physics lab's aim to train students in assembling and operating apparatus, taking and interpreting data and presenting the results of an experiment in a written report.
- The laboratories are well equipped with a large number of instruments like, GMC (Geiger Muller Counter), Grating, Four Probe, LCR circuit, RC Transmission Line, Solar cell, Electronic Balance, Newton's Ring Apparatus, Carry Foster Bridge, Random Decay Apparatus, Rectifier, Filter circuits, Fresnel Bi-prism, Operation Amplifier, Black Body Radiation, Stefan's Constant, Compound Pendulum, Conversion of Galvanometer to Ammeter and Galvanometer to Voltmeter, Converter Analog to Digital and Digital to Analog Converter etc.

## CHEMISTRY LAB

*"Science is curiosity, testing and experimenting."*

- The department has three spacious built laboratories that can accommodate 30 students at the time of practical class.
- The laboratory is well stocked with sufficient chemicals so that every student gets the opportunity to carry out the experiments. It is executed by devoted and expert faculties of the department. The department has strengthened the laboratory infrastructure facilities by incorporating modern practical techniques like Spectrophotometer, TDS meter, Vacuum pump, Digital centrifuge, Digital balance, pH Meter, Double Distillation unit, Magnetic Stirrer, Heating Mantle and Digital Potentiometer etc. to enhance the experimental skills of the students.
- Moreover, the safety of every student while handling the chemicals and instruments is duly taken care off.

## ZOOLOGY LAB

*"A zoologist is delighted by the difference between animals, whereas the physiologists would like all animals to work in fundamentally the same way."*

- The department has two spacious and well equipped laboratories with capacity of 30 students each to conduct practical classes.
- All the laboratories have necessary infrastructure and equipment to conduct practical classes in the field of Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, and Ecology etc. prescribed as per syllabus.
- The laboratory is equipped with diverse apparatus like Hot Air Oven, High Speed Centrifuge, Digital Balance, pH Meter, Binocular Microscope, Simple and Compound Microscope, Distillation Unit, Autoclave, Hot Plate, Water Bath, Colony Counter, Refrigerator, Heating Mantle, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters.
- In the laboratory there is a large museum with well stocked syllabi wise specimens.



# AMENITIES



## BOTANY LAB

*"Botany, the science of vegetable kingdom is one of the most attractive, most useful and most extensive departments of human knowledge. It is, above every other, the science of beauty"*

- The department has two well established, well-equipped, spacious, well ventilated laboratories having capacity of conducting practical tasks of 30 students at a time.
- The laboratory gives the facility to the students to be acquainted with various equipments like Spectrophotometer, Digital Balance, Centrifuge, Autoclave, Laminar Air Flow, Microtome, Ganong's potometer, Farmers Potometer, Ganong's Respirometer, Digital pH Meter, Hot Plate, Digital Balance, Incubator, Auxanometer, Binocular Microscope, Simple and Compound Microscope, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters. In addition to these, there is a large museum well stacked with syllabus wise specimens.

## BOTANICAL GARDEN

*"The glory of gardening, hands in the dirt,  
head in the sun, heart with nature.*

*To nurture a garden is to feed not just the body, but the soul"*

The college has its own botanical garden. The aim of establishing botanical garden is to educate our students regarding collection, cultivation and conservation of plants. Our garden include a green house, shade house and collection of medicinal plants like *Tinosporacordifolia*, *Aloevera*, *Withaniasomnifera*, ornamental plants like *Dahlia*, *Ixora* and several other plants. A beautiful and artificial pond alleviates the garden, which not only enhances the beauty of nature but also provides aquatic study material for students of bio stream. It also includes some more plants like –Hydrophytes: *Hydrilla*, *Eichornia*, and *Nelumbo*; Xerophytes: *Cactus*, *Agave*, *Euphorbia*, *Acacia* etc.

## COMPUTER LAB

*"Computer science is the operating  
system for all innovations"*

The department maintains two Hi-tech, LAN connected centralized server system computer laboratories with LCD projector, Wi-Fi facility and seating capacity of 100 students. Students receive personal assistance and help with campus logins, basic computer questions and locating information from supporting and knowledgeable staff members. The computers in these labs are equipped with the Microsoft Office applications and other software as per the requirement of students. The Personal Computer of the lab is updated with the syllabus wise software helpful for BCA students and impart elementary knowledge to other students.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

## RULES and REGULATIONS for the students

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

1. Admissions to the various courses are done strictly as per the eligibility norms laid down by the competent authorities or on the basis of merit in the qualifying exam.
2. Weightage of 3% will be given to all female candidates
3. Weightage of 3% will be given to Jain minorities.
4. Extra marks may also be awarded to the students possessing NCC / NSS / Rovers / Sports certificates. This percentage of marks will be decided as per the guidelines of the State Government or as specified by regulations of Admission Committee.
5. If a student has a gap of more than two regular academic sessions in a regular course then they have to submit gap certificate which should be authorized otherwise a regular/ private student shall not be allowed admission in the next class. Female candidates are exempted from this rule.

### HOW TO FILL THE ADMISSION FORM

#### FOR OFFLINE ADMISSION:

1. Application for admission must be made in prescribed format which is available at the college office of S.S. Jain Subodh College of Global Excellence, Sitapura, Jaipur.
2. The subject combination must be filled in neat and legible handwriting along with all other required details of the qualifying examination, personal details, authentic mobile phone numbers and email id.
3. Affix 3 latest passport size photograph of the candidate on the assigned space in the form.
4. Enclose attested Photostat copies of all the documents mentioned in the admission form.
5. Incomplete application forms and forms reaching after the stipulated time will not be entertained.
6. The duly filled application form should be submitted to the office either by person or by post on or before the last date of submission.

### SELECTION

1. Selected candidates names will be displayed on the notice board of the college. No personal intimation will be sent.
2. The selected students must meet admission committee members with all prescribed documents, within the stipulated time which is mentioned in the merit list displayed on notice board at college.
3. All admissions are subjected to the approval by the University of Rajasthan.

### FEES SUBMISSION

1. Admitted Candidates must deposit the required fee at the respective fee counter to the college through following ways:
  - i) Demand Draft / Pay Order of any bank in Favor of "Principal, S.S. Jain Subodh College of Global Excellence" payable at Jaipur.
  - ii) Online Fee Submission through Net banking/Credit Card/Debit Card by link given on college website: [www.subodhglobalcollege.org](http://www.subodhglobalcollege.org)

**Note: Fee once deposited, will not be refunded in any circumstances.**

2. Students are advised to write in good hand writing their Form No., Name, Father's Name, Class and Contact number on the back of the Demand Draft / Pay Order.
3. After getting admission in a particular faculty, changing from one faculty to the another faculty shall be made on receiving proper

application in prescribed format, only if the marks obtained in the qualifying examination (10+2) are higher than that of the students last admitted in the faculty / class or there is vacant seat in the respective faculty.

4. After admission, a student can change one subject and that too only once, if particular subject / subject combination has vacant seats. The change can be done within 15 days from the date of admission with a fee of Rs 300/- for the same.

- Affidavit/gap certificate for Gap period (if any).

### RULES AND REGULATION OF FEES

- i. It is mandatory for all the students to deposit the fees within stipulated time and if he/she is unable to do so, his/her registration from the college will be cancelled.
- ii. The student has to pay the full fee irrespective of the fact that he has taken the admission in beginning or during the session.
- iii. The fee has to be deposited only in one time, which would include the fees of the session and caution money.
- iv. The student has to pay extra fee if he/she opts Geography.
- v. The fee once deposited will not be refunded in any circumstances except caution money.
- vi. The caution money deposited by the students at the time of admission at the College shall be refunded through account payee cheque only. If any student, in a year, is unable to collect the cheque then his amount will be transferred to Student Alumni Fund.
- vii. All the disputes are subject to Jaipur Jurisdiction only.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

- I. Students shall compulsorily wear the prescribed college uniform on all working days which can be obtained from the uniform distribution counter by showing the fee receipt. Students found without proper uniform will be charged with a fine of Rs.50/- per day.
- II. Every student must carry his/her identity card while entering the campus.
- III. No Guests/visitors shall be allowed with students in the class/lab/library.
- IV. Students must help to keep the institute neat and clean and also preserve and maintain the greeneries.
- V. Students must conserve electricity and water. They must switch off the lights & fans when they leave the classrooms and laboratories.

## PROMOTIONS TO HIGHER CLASSES

- I. Promotion of students to a higher class is not automatic. It is based on a student's satisfactory academic performance, character and conduct during the previous years.
- II. There will be continuous and comprehensive evaluation of students by monthly class tests and Pre University examination at the end of the session, which will be conducted by the college.
- III. Permission for appearing in the annual examination will not be granted unless:
  - A student obtains 75% attendance in each subject at the end of every academic session as per the university rules.
  - A student gets at least the minimum passing marks in the final examination which is conducted by University of Rajasthan.
  - The Principal is satisfied with the character and conduct of the student throughout the year.
- IV. Details of shortage of attendance will be notified to the students timely and students are advised to make up for any shortage caused by any reason.
- V. All disputes / legal matters shall be covered under Jaipur jurisdiction only.

## STUDENT'S UNION ELECTION POLICY

The college prohibits political activities in the campus and forbids students from conducting student union election within the college campus.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION & RULES

- I. Any candidate who has been admitted to the college shall have to abide by the college rules and regulations.
- II. It is compulsory to wear the college uniform and college id-card in the college campus. It indicates equality and a sense of belongingness to the institution.
- III. Vandalism and destruction of college property will be severely dealt with and material loss will be fully recovered with fine.
- IV. Scribbling on walls and furniture is strictly prohibited. Students should see that no damage is done to college property including plants and trees in the campus. They shall not spoil damage or scratch the college property. If anyone is found guilty he/she shall be punished as per the college norms.
- V. Students are not allowed to raise funds without the Principal's permission. If anyone does so, he/she is liable for punishment under the disciplinary code.
- VI. College would not accept any violence, exploitation or harassment in any case by the students. It would be considered as a crime and is punishable as per law.

- VII. Organizing meetings in the college, distributing leaflets, hand-bills or other materials, displaying banners and posters inside the campus without permission is not allowed. If any of these is necessary, then prior permission should be taken from the administration.
- VIII. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones, gadgets or any electronic equipment in the college campus. If these are found, they will be immediately confiscated.
- IX. Smoking, chewing of tobacco, consumption of alcoholic beverages and use of narcotic drugs are strictly prohibited. Criminal proceedings will be taken against those found under the influence of alcohol or narcotic drugs within the campus.
- X. Ragging is totally prohibited on and off the campus. If any candidate is found indulging in any form of ragging, he/she is liable to be punished as per the directive of the UGC and Govt.
- XI. Misconduct, bribing, cheating, or false declaration of any kind is not acceptable and is strictly prohibited.
- XII. Discourtesy towards any member of the staff or any act, which affects the discipline and tone of the college, will be seriously viewed and in extreme cases strict action shall be taken.
- XIII. It is mandatory for every student to inform the college if he/she leaves the college in mid of the session.
- XIV. Students will be allowed to bring their vehicles only up to the designated parking area. Entry beyond that point is strictly prohibited.
- XV. Students are strictly advised not to participate in any discussions, trolling or any such or other kind of activities detrimental to the reputation of the college, departments, staff and students. If any such activity comes to the notice of the Principal, the authority shall initiate appropriate legal action against such individuals.
- XVI. At any stage, if it is found that a candidate has used some fraudulent means to seek admission, or has made incorrect statement (s), he/she shall not be granted admission or if already admitted, such admission shall be cancelled at any stage.
- XVII. During processing or verification of the documents, if any error or omission is found, the college has the right to cancel such kind of admissions.

XVIII. Late applications / incomplete applications / applications without requisite fee / application not submitted on the prescribed form, shall not be entertained.

XIX. The college has not appointed any consultant or outside agency for admission. Candidates should remain cautious and directly contact the Admissions & Counseling office for any query or assistance regarding admission.

## IMPORTANT NOTE TO PARENTS

- I. Parents/guardians are requested to co-operate with the college authorities.
- II. It is the duty of the parents to see that their ward attends the college regularly. Their co-operation will improve the regularity and progress of the ward.
- III. Parents are requested to make sure that their ward appears in class tests and Pre University Examination.
- IV. Parents / guardians are advised to check the records of the attendance of their ward to ensure that their ward is attending classes regularly.

According to the orders of the High Court, it is mandatory for all students to have 75% attendance in the class to be eligible to appear as regular student in the University Examinations.

But this year it was restricted to the flag hoisting only following the guidelines of the pandemic situation by the heads of institutions and the Subodh Shiksha Samiti.
