



THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

The college's vastly expanded campus is situated on 25,000 square yards of land in the picturesque Goner, Ramchandrapura, near to the Akshay Patra Temple in Jagatpura, Jaipur. Modern classrooms and cutting-edge labs are housed in a structure, surrounded by lawns, landscaped gardens, and playground. The college's main building is a four-story structure with a basement that incorporates numerous green construction features, such as a water recycling plant and a rainwater collection system. There is also easy access to transportation from the main cities.

Efforts are being made to develop the campus on green concepts, with special focus on water conservation, the use of alternative sources of energy, green belt development, and sustainable architectural designs of buildings. The campus is aesthetically pleasing, with features like a lush green lawn area, a beautiful botanical garden, and eye-catching perennial and flowering trees grown in a beautiful manner throughout the campus. About 500 plants belonging to different species are maintained here.



THE ADMINISTRATION BLOCK RECEPTION

A very magnificent reception area is the prime place for sorting out and solving all kinds of queries of students, parents, guardians and others. The college staff is available to resolve all the queries regarding counselling, admission procedure and other college related matters during working hours of the college. Faculty and counsellors provide students with guidance based on their abilities, interests, and needs.

THE ADMISSION CELL

A pre-admission counselling unit is established to respond to inquiries and give prospective students general admissions instructions. On working days, the admission counselling cell staff is accessible from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. In order to address any queriesofthe students and their parents may have about admissions and careers, the professors of the relevant courses serve as acting members of the admission committee.

ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

The Administration Office, which is well-equipped and staffed by knowledgeable and committed individuals, is the main hub for organizing and streamlining the college's operations. This also serves as the student's information center.

THE FACULTY ROOM

Our faculty room is ideal for creating a welcoming, professional, and productive atmosphere. It is a large, well-ventilated space with a computer system, Wi-Fi, lockers, and personal space for each faculty member to keep their teaching materials, reference books, and other essentials. Teachers collaborate to improve the learning environment for students.

THE EXAMINATION CELL

The purpose of the examination cell is to ensure that both internal and external examinations are conducted smoothly. Along with managing and organizing University Practical Examinations and Viva-Voice Examinations for BBA/BCA students, it also coordinates with all faculty members to make sure the examination system's stability and authenticity while adhering to University of Rajasthan norms.



The Academic Block

In any knowledge – importing Institution Academic Block is the store house of knowledge that plays a pivotal role. It provides an additional space to the students and teachers to interact with each other for better learning. The Institute has Academic Block with 26 large classrooms, 13 laboratories, two air-conditioned Lecture Hall with seating capacity of 200, two smart classrooms and the faculty room. The walls of the Academic Block are embellished with many motivational quotations, beautiful paintings that make the ambience very inspirational.

The Academic Block houses the following infrastructure:

THE LIBRARY CLASSIFICATION & CATALOGUING:

The College library uses Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme for classifying the books. Classified catalogue code is used to prepare the catalogue entries in the library software.

EASYLIB- LIBRARY AUTOMATION SOFTWARE

Easylib that stands for Entire Automation System for Libraries is an integrated system for library. It performs various functions related to library for improved operations. Library is fully automated using this commercial software. Bar coding is used for book circulation.

REFERENCE SERVICE

A well furnished Reference Section is maintained in the library where staff and students can pick the book of their choice and make reference. Important textbooks, Encyclopaedias, Dictionaries, Reference Books, Multiple volume sets, Dissertations and Question paper sets etc. are displayed in this section.

THE BOOKS & JOURNALS SECTION

The vast library houses a diverse collection of over 5800 books published by leading National and International Publishing Houses in disciplines of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany and Geography), Commerce, Computer Science, Humanities, Business Administration and various magazines, Other Motivational & Inspirational books.

Libraries are gateways to knowledge and culture. The resources and services offered by the library create opportunities for learning, support literacy and education and also help shape new ideas and perspectives that are central to a creative and innovative society. It was established in 2015, since then the library has made consistent progress in terms of collection of books, periodicals, e-resources, services and provides reader friendly infrastructure. It has seating capacity for 100 students at a time.

At present, the library has over 5800 books and bound volumes of journals covering a wide variety of subjects. There is a regular subscription to leading Newspapers, Magazines and Journals thereby augmenting the library as a rich source of knowledge.

Our library is therefore operated on a need based approach rather than the usual rules-based treatment given to students. In addition, we encourage students to read books, periodicals, reference books, journals and competitive magazines etc.

READING SECTION

Reading section provides a focal point for the study and discussion. It aims to stimulate leadership, research, good practice, information and exchange of ideas. It broadens our minds with facts and informational pieces. Library has well-lit and comfortable reading corners for faculty members and the students. The discipline and peace are maintained remarkably by well-trained senior library head and staff.

THE GLOBAL LIBRARY - for the Students by the Students

Self study is the best way of imbibing self-discipline and self management among an individual. Based on this concept, a special library, the Global Library "for the students by the students" was established. This small library is enriched with books on various subjects which are donated by the faculty members from time to time. It has a well planned infrastructure too for reading and seating. A few volunteer students run this small library and manage the accounting themselves.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LIBRARY

Admittance: Students must show their identity cum library card and sign in/out at the register located at the library gate for entry.

Library Card: Each student is issued one library card, and two books can be borrowed per card. Cards are non-transferable.

Loan Period: Students can borrow books for 14 days, and if not requested by another student, they can be renewed for an additional 14 days.

Overdue Books: Failure to return books within the stipulated period will result in a fine of Rs. 5 per day per book. Readers are responsible for books issued under their names.

Book Recall: The library reserves the right to recall any issued book before the due date.

Lost Books: If a borrowed book is lost, the borrower must replace it with a copy of the same or latest edition. Failure to replace the book will result in a fine double the cost of the book.

Barcode Damage: Any damage caused to the barcode of a book will incur a fine of Rs. 100 per book, as the library is automated/computerized.

Lost Library ID: In case of a lost Library ID, a duplicate may be issued upon payment of Rs. 100.

Personal Belongings: Personal items like bags and laptops are not allowed inside the library and should be deposited at the entrance.





Deliberation is a great way to communicate and vital for the development and enhancement of an individual and education system as a whole. The college's seminar halls and auditoriums offer state-of-the-art amenities and facilities. With a seating capacity of 400 each, these hi-tech venues are well-lit and equipped with luxurious seating arrangements.

The auditoriums boast modern features such as whiteboards, LCD projectors, and high-quality sound systems, catering to diverse educational needs. Additionally, both the halls are fully air-conditioned, ensuring comfort for all participants. These versatile spaces serve as regular venues for a myriad of activities including, conferences, exhibitions, workshops, seminars, presentations, and cultural events.

CLASSROOM AND TUTORIAL ROOMS

The Academic block boasts thirty spacious and well-lit classrooms, including two stateof-the-art lecture theatres accommodating up to 100 students each. Additionally, there are twenty-four lecture rooms with a capacity of 60-70 students and four tutorial rooms catering to 30 students each, providing an immersive and insightful learning environment for all students.

SMART CLASSROOMS

To keep pace with the technological advancement in pedagogy of teaching and making learning an exhilarating experience, the college has smart class rooms to cater to the smart generation of new India. These smart classrooms leverage engaging visuals and animations to elucidate complex concepts, fostering an enjoyable learning journey for students and enhancing their academic performance significantly.

AMENITIES

LABORATORIES

Working in laboratories is the first hands-on experience any student gets in his/her career. Colleges emphasizes more on advanced studies through practical learning. Laboratories have different design features which depend on the type of work or experiments. At 5.5 Jain Subodh College of Global Excellence, we have acquired well equipped laboratories with latest instruments related to all Science subjects (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography and Zoology) and Computer Science laboratory with latest technical hardware and software which fulfil both students' expectations and the curriculum standards of the University of Rajasthan.



PHYSICS LAB


"The only Rules are the ones dictated by the law of physics. Everything else is a recommendation."

- The Department has three well established laboratories each capable of accommodating a capacity of 30 students. These labs are designed to teach students basic concepts and principles of physics, related to laboratory experiments and their applications.
- Laboratory is well equipped with instrument's including a Geiger Muller Counter(GMC), Grating Four Probe, LCR circuit, RC Transmission Line, Solar cell, Electronic Balance, Newton's Ring Apparatus, Carry Foster Bridge, Random Decay Apparatus, Rectifier, Filter circuits, Fresnel Bi-prism, Operational Amplifier, Black Body Radiation apparatus, Stefan's Constant apparatus, Compound Pendulum, Conversion of Galvanometer to Ammeter and Galvanometer to Voltmeter apparatus, Analog to Digital and Digital to Analog Converter, etc.



"Chemistry is not just a science; it is an art and way of life. Every aspect of our lives is deeply affected by chemistry and its marvels. It is a bond that keeps everything connected and related."

- The department has three large laboratories that may accommodate up to 30 students during practical lessons. Our labs are well-stocked with chemicals, allowing students to do hands-on investigations under the guidance of experienced faculty members
- The laboratory infrastructure is constantly updated with procedures and cutting edge equipment, including Spectrophotometer, TDS meters, Vacuum pumps, Digital centrifuges, Digital balances, pH Meters, Double Distillation units, Magnetic Stirrers, Heating Mantles, and Digital Potentiometers. These new technologies not only improve the learning experience, but they also help students to develop their experimental abilities. Importantly, the department promotes student safety, putting in place strong safeguards to protect persons when handling chemicals and instruments.



ZOOLOGY LAB

"Zoology is the excellent place to study habits of all human beings. It is not just the study of species but it is the study of life in all forms."

- The department contains two spacious and well-equipped laboratories with capacity for 30 students each to conduct practical lessons. The laboratories have the essential infrastructure and equipment for practical sessions in Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, and Ecology, as per the syllabus.
- The laboratory has a variety of equipment, including Hot Air Oven, High Speed Centrifuge, Digital Balance, pH Meter, Binocular Microscope, Simple and Compound Microscope, Distillation Unit, Autoclave, Hot Plate, Water Bath, Colony Counter, Refrigerator, Heating Mantle, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters. In the laboratory, there is a big museum with well-stocked syllabi-related exhibits.

BOTANY LAB

"Botany- the science of the vegetable kingdom, is one of the most attractive, most useful, and most extensive departments of human knowledge. It is, above every other, the science of beauty"

- There are two advanced labs in the department that can hold up to 30 students at once. These large, well-ventilated spaces are equipped with comprehensive array of equipment's including Spectrophotometers, Digital Balances, Centrifuges, Autoclaves, Laminar Air Flows, Microtomes, Ganong Potometers, Farmer's Potometers, Gnongs Respirometers, Digital pH Meters, Hot Plates, incubators Auxanometers, Binocular Microscopes, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters
- Students' educational experience is further enhanced by having access to a large museum that has carefully chosen exhibits that are in line with the curriculum.





BOTANICAL GARDEN "Botanical gardens are the living canvas where nature's colors come to life where Every plant has a story to tell."

- The goal of establishing a botanical garden is to give our students a learning environment where they may study the collection, cultivation, and preservation of plants.
- A wide variety of plant species, including therapeutic ones, may be found in our garden such as Inspira cordifolia and Aloe vera, as well as ornamental plants like Dahlia and Ixora.

In addition to our greenhouse and shade house, we have incorporated a picturesque artificial pondwhich not only adds to the garden's natural beauty but also offers students who are interested in aquatic biology useful study materials.

GEOGRAPHY LAB

"Geography is about more than just memorizing places on a map. It's about understanding the complexity of our world, appreciating the diversity of cultures that exists across continent."



COMPUTER LAB

"A computer is not a device anymore. It is an extension of your mind and your gateway to other people."



A well-stocked laboratory with all the maps, charts, and other tools required to teach geography is maintained by the Department of Geography. Students whether individually or in groups, utilize these resources to solve geographical problems. Additionally, the laboratory facilitates the transformation of field-collected data or statistical report and diagrams

The department maintains two state-of-the-art computer labs with LCD projectors, Wi-Fi, and a centralized server system that is connected to a local area network (LAN). Each lab can accommodate up to 100 students. The computers in these labs are equipped with Microsoft Office applications, latest versions of programming language software such as VS Code, My SQL Server etc and other software as per the requirements of students. The personal computers in the lab are updated with syllabus-wise software helpful for BCA students and provide elementary knowledge to other students.

COMMERCE LAB

The lab's layout supports both individual and group work, allowing instructors to effectively guide and oversee activities.

- III. If a student secures a minimum of 48 credits in the first year, he/she will be promoted by the university with the remark "PASS" in the second year. If he/she wants to exit after first year with "CERTIFICATE OF FACULTY/DISCIPLINE" then a minimum of 48 credits from course and 4 credits from internship to be earned.
- IV. If the minimum number of credits acquired by the student in the first year is less than 48, then on securing a minimum of 18 credits (50% of total credits 36 in core subjects) and a minimum of 26 credits (50% of total credits 52) in the first year will be promoted with the remark "BACK PROMOTED". In his second year, he can again earn the required credits by appearing in the relevant subjects of the first and second semesters.
- Otherwise, the student will become an EX-STUDENT with the remark "FAIL".
- In any year the student cannot appear in all the examinations of any one semester of the previous year.
- For promotion from the current year to the next year, it is mandatory to pass all the prescribed co-courses of the previous year with a minimum of C grades (40%).
- VIII. The maximum period to complete the first year is three years, and for this, the student must have earned a minimum of 48 credits.

Scheme of Examination-

1 credit = 25 marks for examination/evaluation

Continuous assessment, in which sessional work and the terminal examination will contribute to the final grade. Each course in Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) has two components- Continuous

assessment (20% weightage) and (End of Semester Examination) EoSE (80% weightage).

- Sessional work will consist of class tests, mid-semester examinations, homework assignments, etc., as determined by the faculty in charge of the courses of study.
- Each Paper of EoSE shall carry 80% of the total marks of the course/subject. The EoSE will be of 3 hour duration.
- 3. 75% Attendance is mandatory for appearing in EoSE.
- To appear in the EoSE examination of a course/subject student must appear in the mid-semesterexamination and obtain at least C grade in the course/subject.

PROMOTION TO HIGHER CLASSES

- Promotion to a higher class is not automatic and depends on the student's academic performance, character, and behaviour during the previous years.
- The college will conduct continuous and comprehensive evaluations through monthly tests and Mid-Term exams.
- To be eligible to appear for the Annual Examination, the following conditions must be met:
 - The student must have at least 75% attendance in each subject by the end of the academic year, as per university regulations.
 - The student must achieve the minimum passing marks in the final examination conducted by the University of Rajasthan.
 - The Principal must be satisfied with the student's behavior and character throughout the year.
- Any student with short attendance will be notified in a timely manner, and they are expected to compensate for any absences.
- All legal disputes or matters will be subject to the jurisdiction of Jaipur only.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students must wear the prescribed college uniform on all working days. The uniform can be obtained from the distribution counter by presenting the fee receipt. A fine of Rs. 50 will be imposed on students not wearing the college uniform.


